Margot Krasojević's 3D printed light acts as a vertical axis wind turbine. Inspired by the Ropatec wind rotor, its form uses the principles of aerodynamics to behave like a wind propeller. The Air Turbine light is made from white ceramic and is comprised of a propeller, a rotor arm and an alternator to produce the electricity that is stored to light the LED. The Slate Table Copper, Special Edition from Nikolas Kerl is a coffee table that lives from the contrasting characteristics of two materials. The frame is manufactured from a single piece of flat steel that is laser cut into a cruciform shape, bent and copper-plated with a high-polish finish. The smooth, reflective surface takes on the colour of its environment while it holds the unfinished, rough slate slab in place.
